ANNEXURE-IV

SCHEME FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR EDUCATION OF THE CHILDREN OF REGISTERED CONSTRUCTION WORKER:

Under the rule 279 of The Tripura State Building and Other Construction Workers (RE & CS) Rules 2001, the scheme for **Education Benefit** is hereby made as follows:

To give financial assistance for education of children of a registered construction workers having a continuous registration for a period of six months under TBOCWWB.

1. The rate of the scholarship for different courses/subjects is as follows:

Level of Study	Stipend
Class 1 to 5	Rs. 1,800/- year
Class 6 to 8	Rs. 2,400/- year
Class 9 to 10	Rs. 4,000/- year
All post-matriculation level non-degree courses for which entrance qualification is High School (Class X), e.g. senior secondary certificate (class XI and XII); both general and vocational stream, ITI courses, 3 year diploma courses in Polytechnics, etc.	Rs. 4,000/- year
Post Matric Scholarship	
Group 1: (i) Degree and Post Graduate level courses which including M.Phil., Ph.D. and Post-Doctoral research in Medicine (Allopathic, Indian and other recognized systems of medicines), Engineering, Technology, Planning, Architecture, Design, Fashion Technology, Agriculture, Veterinary & Allied Sciences, Management, Business Finance /Administration, Computer Science/ Applications. (ii) Commercial Pilot License (including helicopter pilot and multiengine rating) course. (iii) Post Graduate Diploma courses in various branches of management & medicine. (iv) C.A./I.C.W.A./C.S./I.C.F.A. etc. (v) M.Phil., Ph.D. and Post-Doctoral Programmes (D. Litt., D.Sc. etc.) – a) In existing Group 2 courses b) In existing Group 3 courses	Rs.20000/- year
Group 2: (i) Graduate/ Post Graduate courses leading to Degree, Diploma, Certificate in areas like Pharmacy (B Pharma), Nursing (B Nursing), LLB, BFS, other para-medical branches like rehabilitation, diagnostics etc., Mass Communication, Hotel Management& Catering, Travel/Tourism/Hospitality Management, Interior Decoration, Nutrition & Dietetics, Commercial Art, Financial Services (e.g. Banking, Insurance, Taxation etc.) for which entrance qualification is minimum Sr. Secondary (10+2). (ii) Post Graduate courses not covered under Group-I e.g. M.A./M.Sc./M.Com./M.Ed./M.Pharma etc.	12000/- year
Group 3: All other courses leading to a graduate degree not covered under Group 1&2 eg. BA/B Sc/B Com etc.	Rs.10,000/-year

2. Subject to specified conditions mentioned elsewhere, the general conditions of eligibility are given below: -

- The scholarships are open to children of construction workers registered with the Building & Other Construction Workers' Welfare Board.
- These scholarships will be awarded for the study of all recognized Pre-Matric and Post-Matric courses pursued in recognized institutions, with the exception of courses with duration of 6 months or less.
- Candidates who after passing one stage of education, are studying in the same stage of education in different subjects for instance Class XI Arts after Class XI Science or B.A. after B.Sc. or M.A. in one subject after M.A. in another subject will NOT be eligible.
- Candidates who, after having completed their educational career in one professional stream, continue professional studies in a different stream for instance LLB after B.Ed. will NOT be eligible. Students will be allowed to take up only one professional stream.
- Candidates applying for Post-Matric scholarship should possess the relevant qualification from any recognized institution. An original certificate from the institution of study must be produced by the candidate
- Candidate under full employment during the period of study shall not be eligible for the scholarship.
- Candidates pursuing part-time courses will not be eligible.
- The scholarship shall be tenable for the prescribed duration of a course. A candidate who is in receipt of the scholarship, but failing to pass in a particular year shall not receive further scholarship till he/ she passes the specific year of the course. The institution shall certify to that effect.
- Certificate of the Head of Institute of School, College and university stating that the student is reading in which class during the year.
- Application must be submitted within 6 months of the next academic year.
- It should be ensured that the beneficiary ward maintains 50% of the annual attendance in the class.
- Only two children of the same parents/ guardians will be entitled to receive scholarships.
- The registered construction workers shall have no dues payable to the Board.
- Home study courses, online courses and distance courses etc are not eligible to avail this benefit.

3. Supporting Documents:

- Bank Account Details
- Prescribed application form.
- Copy of BOC worker registration card
- Mark sheet of a student
- Any other documents as and when required.

4. How to apply: The registered beneficiary will apply in prescribed form through electronically. The concerned Labour Inspector will process and verify the application and Labour Officer will review and approved the application.
